



## Retrospectiva anului 2010 - Asociatia Little People Romania

Asociatia Little People Romania desfosoara zilnic activitati in unitatile onco-pediatriche din Romania. Mai jos gasiti prezentarea celor mai importante si speciale evenimente petrecute in anul 2010.

- In luna ianuarie, Katie Rizvi, fondatorul Asociatiei Little People Romania, a castigat premiul „Femeia anului”, eveniment desfasurat la Bucuresti, Romania.
- 15 februarie 2010 – a fost lansata Campania “Poti Si Tu!” care este cunoscuta de publicul din intreaga tara prin intermediul bratarilor galbene ce poarta inscriptia „TEMERARII stiu ca se poate – Poti Si Tu!”. Fiecare canal de televiziune din Romania a transmis mesajul Poti Si Tu! – TVR, Pro TV, Antena 1, Prima Tv, Kanal D, Realitatea TV, Acasa TV, National TV si altele, iar moderatorii acestora au purtat si au prezentat in direct bratarile galbene. Intr-o singura saptamana, de la prezentarea acestora pe canalele media, au fost comandate on-line 6000 de bratari. Pe parcursul anului 2010 au fost distribuite publicului larg, si nu numai, peste 25000 de bratari si au fost obtinuti peste 22000 euro.
- In luna martie, Little People a deschis Cluj Community Center – Centrul de Pregatire si Informare, spatiu gratuit pentru instruire si pregatire pus la dispozitia ONG-urilor si micilor companii, cu scopul de a stimula cresterea si dezvoltarea importantei lor in cadrul comunitatii clujene.
- Pentru prima data in Romania, oncologi pediatri, psihologi, supravietuitori in lupta cu cancerul, parinti, pacienti curenti si specialisti in domeniul dezvoltarii copilului au colaborat la crearea unei brosuri informative pentru parintii copiilor diagnosticați cu cancer, numita Ghid pentru Parinti. Ghidul este disponibil gratuit in fiecare unitate onco-pediatrica din Romania – Asociatia Little People Romania si Clubul Temerarii au fost partenerii principali ai companiei DANONE Romania in productia acestui ghid.
- Campania „Poti Si Tu!” a castigat un premiu la Gala Societatii Civile la Bucuresti.
- Dupa perioada de selectie si instruire a voluntarilor ce a avut loc in luna martie, Little People si-a inceput programul zilnic de suport a copiilor bolnavi de cancer in cadrul Spitalului “Louis Turcanu” din Timisoara. Anual, 300 de copii beneficiaza de aceste servicii.
- In luna mai, Asociatia Little People a castigat premiul „Implicare extraordinara in comunitate” – premiul a fost inmanat de Primarul Lord al orasului City of London.
- In luna iunie, Little People a co-organizat cea de a patra editie a campionatului RITTO (Romanian International Table Tennis Open), cel mai mare eveniment paralimpic desfasurat pe teritoriul Romaniei, care a castigat mai multe premii internationale pentru calitatea serviciilor de voluntariat decat orice alt proiect desfasurat in Romania. Sprijinul financiar din partea E-on Group completat de prezenta celor 200 de atleti internationali si de atentia si amabilitatea celor 700 de voluntari romani fac din acest eveniment, desfasurat pe parcursul a patru zile, cel mai prestigios eveniment de acest gen din Romania.

- Campania "Poti Si Tu!" soseste la Timisoara in luna iulie - 6000 de bratari au fost distribuite publicului din Timisoara - Primaria Timisoara si-a exprimat recunostinta si aprecierea pentru activitatile desfasurate de Asociatia Little People in sectia de oncologie.
- In luna august echipa de fotbal Manchester City isi manifesta suportul pentru Campania "Poti Si Tu!". Fotbalistii fascinati de mesajul rasunator al Clubului Temerari au purtat bratarile galbene pe parcursul a doua meciuri si au promovat Campania "Poti Si Tu!" pe site-ul oficial al echipei. <http://www.mcfc.co.uk/Video/Features/City-stars-meet-children-from-Romanian-Little-People-charity>
- 13 septembrie a marcat prima zi din Tabara Temerarii desfasurata la Gilau pentru o saptamana, unde au participat peste 100 de tineri care au invins cancerul din intreaga tara. A avut loc prima Adunare Generala in care s-au luat hotarari asupra felului in care vor fi cheltuite fondurile obtinute in urma Campaniei "Poti Si Tu!" Tinerii au decis ca 30% din fonduri sa sustina programele initiate la spitalul din Iasi, 30% sa fie oferiti doctorilor pentru a achizitiona medicamente greu de obtinut, 30% pentru continuarea Campaniei Poti Si Tu! si 10% pentru intalniri marca Temerarii.
- In luna octombrie Campania "Poti Si Tu!" castiga „Premiul special pentru implicare deosebita in comunitate” la prestigiosul eveniment PR Awards Romania si recunoasterea specialistilor din domeniu. Acest premiu reprezinta o deosebita realizare, tinand cont ca aceasta campanie a fost initata cu doar 400 de euro.
- Ziua LiveSTRONG in Romania a fost celebrata in 4 judete din tara de catre Asociatia Little People Romania, care se alatura campaniei globale si isi uneste fortele cu cei 28 de milioane de pacienti bolnavi de cancer din jurul lumii pentru a-si oferi suportul in lupta impotriva cancerului. Trupe de rock din Romania si-au manifestat suportul purtand in acea zi bratarile galbene in timpul concertelor sustinute.
- Noiembrie – debutul activitatilor Asociatiei Little People in Spitalul „Sfanta Maria” din Iasi. Astfel, Asociatia Little People Romania ofera zilnic servicii pentru 80% din copiii tratati impotriva cancerului in Romania in 5 centre regionale de tratament.
- Decembrie – deschiderea si oficializarea camerei de joaca si terapie din Spitalul „Sfanta Maria” din Iasi. Pentru prima data copiii spitalizati in aceasta unitate de tratament se pot bucura de o camera de joaca, si prima data cand un astfel de proiect a fost desfasurat de catre fosti pacienti tratati in spitale romanesti. Cei 22000 de euro obtinuti prin vanzarea bratarilor "Poti Si Tu!" au contribuit la realizarea acestei camere, care reprezinta primul proiect sustinut financiar de clubul TEMERARII.
- Clubul de fotbal Liverpool isi arata sprijinul pentru Campania Poti Si Tu! si amplaseaza in legendara camera a trofeelor din Anfield o rama cu mesajul „Va multumim ca sustineti adolescentii romani in lupta lor impotriva cancerului” din partea Clubului Temerarii.

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## The Little People Association Romania Year in Review 2010

As we close 2010 the Little People Association now works daily, providing patient support services in 5 onco-paediatric hospital wards in Romania (Iasi, Bucharest, Cluj Napoca and Timisoara). This is a huge achievement and is the 1st time in Romania's history that one service provider is available in all major treatment centers and ensures that 80% of all children being treated for cancer in Romania will have access to volunteer psycho-social services on a daily basis. Within the first two weeks of 2011 the Little People have been formally asked to work in two more hospitals in Bucharest. We had a meeting with Dr Arion of the Fundeni Hematology department and Dr Scurtu of Marie Curie's paediatric oncology unit. Both want Little People to work permanently in their hospital sections in 2011. This will ensure every child fighting cancer in Romania will have access to psycho-social support services. - **What a great way to start 2011!**

Below are a few highlights of 2010 and our achievements with the help of our trusted friends, supporters, sponsors in other words – YOU!!! Thank you!

- We started the year with an award. Katie Rizvi, founder of Little People won the "Woman of the Year" for her work within cancer care Romania.
- February 15, The Poti si Tu wish band was launched campaign. The wish band carries the message "Poti Si Tu". Every major TV network in Romania carried the story of Poti Si Tu! – TVR1, Pro TV, Antena 1, Prima TV, Kanal D, Reality TV, Acasa TV, National TV and others, TV anchors and moderators wore the yellow bracelets while presenting live on TV. Within a week over 6,000 bracelets were ordered online. By the end of the year we have publicly distributed over 25,000 bracelets and raised more than 22,000 euros for the Temerarii Club to decide how to be spent within cancer care.
- In March for the first time in Romania, paediatric oncologists, psychologists, cancer survivors, parents, current patients and specialists in child development have collaborated to create an informative brochure for parents of children diagnosed with cancer. The Parent Guide is freely available in every onco-paediatric unit in Romania. Little People have been promoting the booklet on each ward and at international conferences and patient action groups. The Little People Association and Temerarii were the main partners in the production of this guide.
- Poti Si Tu! won an award at the Gala of Civil Society in Bucharest, beating the likes of World vision, Save the Children, WWF. etc
- After the selection and training of volunteers that took place in March, Little People began the daily support services for children with cancer in the Hospital "Louis Turcanu" of Timisoara. Annually over 300 children will benefit from these services.
- In May the Little People Association won an award for 'extraordinary community involvement'- the award and prize money was given by the Lord Mayor of the City of London.
- In June, Little People, co-organized the fourth edition of the championship RITTO (Romanian International Table Tennis Open), the biggest Paralympic event held in Romania and in Central and Eastern Europe, RITTO has won several international awards for best voluntary services.

- In August Manchester City football team gives its support for the "Poti Si Tu." Campaign. The world's leading Footballers support the campaign and wear yellow wristbands during their two matches in Romania and the UK the event is posted on the team's official website. <http://www.mcfc.co.uk/Video/Features/City-stars-meet-children-from-Romanian-Little-People-charity>
- September 13 marked the first day of Temerarii camp held at Gilau for a week, attended by over 100 young people across the country who have defeated cancer. The first Temerarii general assembly was held in which decisions were made on how to spend the campaign funds obtained through the sale of the "Poti Si Tu" wish bands. Temerarii decided that, 30% to help create the Iasi playroom, and 30% will be offered to doctors to buy drugs difficult to obtain, 30% for continuing the Poti Si Tu Campaign and 10% for Temerarii meetings. <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=xlkpXVu3850&feature=related>
- In October the Poti Si Tu! campaign wins the Romanian PR award for "Outstanding community involvement". This award is a great achievement, considering that the campaign was started with a 400 euro investment.
- LIVESTRONG Day was celebrated in four cities across Romania by the Little People Association. The day joins the global campaign and joins forces with the over 28 million cancer patients around the world to offer support in the fight against cancer. Every major Romanian Rock band from Romania gave their support by wearing the wishbands during their live concerts this week.
- November - the beginning of activities in the Hospital "Saint Mary" in Iasi. Now the Little People Association offers their daily services in five regional cancer centers.
- December - opening of a play therapy room in the "Saint Mary" Hospital, in Iasi. This is the 1st time the children have place to play and do activities outside of the bedrooms. This undertaking was decided on and developed by Temerarii. The 22,000 Euro-project was funded by the Poti si Tu fund set up by TEMERARII, by OMV Petrom sponsorship, Danone Employees' donation and gift-matching program and the British embassy!
- Liverpool football club show their support towards Poti Si Tu! and place in the legendary trophy room in Anfield a framed message from the Temerarii Club that says: "Thank you for supporting our fight against cancer".
- 2010 Christmas Gala – Over 100 Temerarii members from across Romania celebrated Christmas together. The event was held at the Radisson Blu 5 star hotel in Bucharest. As the Pro TV report said – "this day is proof that cancer can be beaten"



#### **Also in 2010 –**
